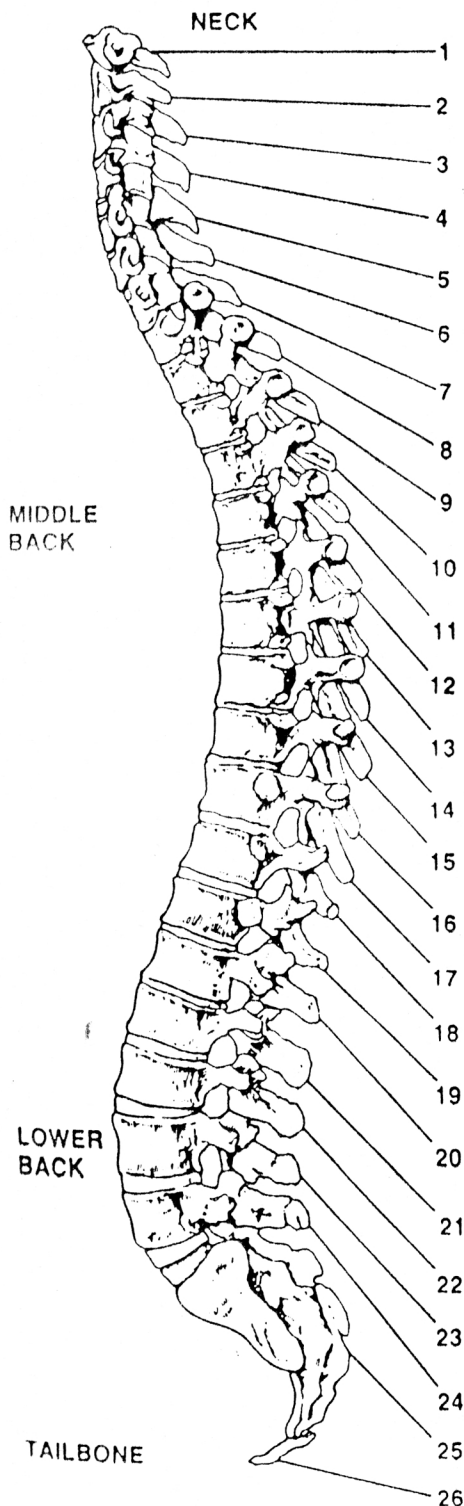


A Chiropractic View of the Spine



	Area Supplied by Nerves	Possible Results of Nerve Impingement
	All tissues, glands, and organs are supplied with electrical energy by each spinal nerve	Partial list of conditions and symptoms that may possibly result when there is an absence of electricity in the nerves.
C1	1 Blood supply to head, pituitary gland, scalp, face bones, brain itself, inner & middle ear, sympathetic nervous system.	Headaches, nervousness, insomnia, head colds, high blood pressure, migraines, mental breakdowns, chronic tiredness, dizziness, vertigo.
C2	2 Eyes, optic nerve, auditory nerve, sinuses, mastoid bones, tongue, forehead.	Sinus trouble, allergies, crossed eyes, deafness, eye trouble, carache, fainting spells.
C3	3 Cheeks, outer ear, face bones, teeth, facial nerve.	Neuralgia, neuritis, acne, eczema.
C4	4 Nose, lips, mouth, eustachian tubes.	Hay fever, runny nose, hearing problems, adenoid problems.
C5	5 Vocal cords, neck glands, pharynx.	Laryngitis, hoarseness, sore throat.
C6	6 Neck & shoulders muscles, tonsils.	Stiff neck, pain in upper arm, tonsilitis, whooping cough, croup.
C7	7 Thyroid gland, shoulder bursa, elbows.	Buritis, colds, thyroid conditions, goiter.
T1	8 Forearms, wrists, hands, fingers, esophagus, trachea.	Asthma, cough, difficult breathing, shortness of breath, pain in forearms.
T2	9 Coronary arteries, heart including valves & covering.	Functional heart conditions, certain chest pains.
T3	10 Lungs, bronchial tubes, pleura, breast, nipples.	Bronchitis, pleurisy, pneumonia, congestion, influenza, grippe.
T4	11 Gall bladder, common duct.	Gall bladder conditions, jaundice.
T5	12 Liver, solar plexus, blood.	Liver conditions, low blood pressure, anemia, poor circulation, arthritis.
T6	13 Stomach	Nervous stomach, indigestion, heartburn, dyspepsia.
T7	14 Pancreas, Islet of Langerhans, duodenum.	Diabetes, ulcers, gastritis.
T8	15 Spleen, diaphragm.	Stomach problems, hiccups.
T9	16 Adrenal Gland	Allerges, hives.
T10	17 Kidneys	Kidney problems, hardening of the arteries, chronic tiredness.
T11	18 Kidneys ureters.	Skin conditions (acne), eczema, boils etc..
T12	19 Small intestines, fallopian tubes, lymph circulation	Rheumatism, gas pains, certain types of sterility.
L1	20 Large intestines, colon, inguinal region.	Constipation, colitis, dysentary, diarrhea, hernias.
L2	21 Appendix, abdomen, upper leg, cecum.	Appendicitis, cramps, difficult breathing, acidosis, varicose veins.
L3	22 Bladder, knee, sex organs (ovaries & testicles)	Bladder troubles, many knee pains.
L4	23 Prostate glands, muscles in the lower leg (sciatica).	Sciatica, lumbago, urination troubles, backaches.
L5	24 Lower legs, ankles, feet, toes and arches.	Poor leg circulation, swollen ankles, weak ankles & arches, cold feet, weakness in legs, leg cramps.
sacrum	25 Hip bones, buttocks.	Sacroiliac problems, spinal curvatures.
coccyx	26 Rectum, anus.	Hemorrhoids, pain at base of spine while sitting.
